President Jones called the meeting to order, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Mr. Hanson moved to approve Resolution 13-1-1 for Town Council Salaries, Mr. Eickhoff seconded. The motion carried.

Mr. Eickhoff moved we accept Resolution 13-1-2 for Huehls Sealcoating to do the Town's garss cutting & snow plowing, etc. subject to last year's pricing. Mr. Hanson seconded. The motion carried.

Mr. Eickhoff moved and Mr. Mosier seconded appointing Rex M. Joseph as town attorney. The motion carried.

Mr. Eickhoff moved and Mr. Mosier seconded appointing John Ryan as town marshal. The motion carried.

Public Comments was next Gary Loveless, Indy Clean Up 4/6/13. Burmese America Institute opened across the hall from Homecroft's office, 9000 Burmese now live in Perry Twp. There will be a GSBA meeting 2/27 @ German American Park, 7 PM. Flora permits for trees in the right of way are free and available on line. Mayor's Night out at St. Ann Catholic Church on 2/12 @ 6 PM. On 03/6/13 a Greenways meeting will be held @ PMHS Library @ 6:30 PM. He also advised that if any need the services of Nurse Family Partnership, who help with care for newborns up to 2 years old.

Public Works Report – Mr. Mosier distributed an ADA Plan for the town and gave an explanation. Dave Kieser updated the council on the sign project and presented a timeline for the council and gave an explanation of the delay. Mr. Mosier will be receiving e-mail updates from Dave Kieser on the project. The town expressed their concern about the delays and the desire for expediting this project. Dave Kieser will write a letter to be posted on the town's website and will be meeting with Mr. Mosier monthly until this project is completed. After Dave Kieser left, the council further discussed the sign project and options that the town may have.

President Jones advised she received a letter from David Wantz concerning the town donating \$1000 towards the Madison Avenue Corridor project. After the group met with the town C/T Coomes on the advice of Attorney Joseph contacted Charlie Pride, IN SBOA, about a possible donation. We were advised that unless the group could provide a contract as to what they could provide to the town as a tangible benefit, we could not donate. The President advised we were not to going to make a donation and would advise David Wantz.

Special Projects Report – The ADA documents are on the website. President Jones asked that a statement be put on our website about trash and that the trash must be in bags and in the receptacle.

Police Department Report - 1770 Loretta was burglarized 12/31. Our chaplain passed away in Jan. Officer Linville has resigned. Right Express card application has been approved. Chief Ryan & Mr. Eickhoff discussed the current ammunition shortage and the length of time it will take to fulfill any order. Mr. Eickhoff moved that we spend \$7742.45 for duty ammunition as it will come in sporadically and a case here and a case there over the next 15-18 months it was seconded by Mr. Hanson. The motion carried. There will be a swearing ceremony on 2/5 @ 6 PM for the new officers.

Other Old/New Business - May meeting moved to 5/22. President Jones thanked the council for the flowers for her recent hospital stay.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Mr. Mosier @ 8:33 PM it was seconded by Mr. Hanson. The motion passed.
