President Jones called the meeting to order, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

A motion was made by Mr. Eickhoff to approve the minutes of the Town's June 20, 2012 regular meeting; it was seconded by Mr. Hanson. The motion carried. A motion was made by Mr. Eickhoff to approve the July 2012 claims. It was seconded by Mr. Hanson, the motion was approved.

Public Comments – Gary Loveless arrived about 7:45PM. The bridge on Southport Rd over Little Buck Creek is being replaced next year and the proposed closure is 3/30/13 to 6/30/13. Gary talked about storm drain marking. Miracle Mile Parade meeting 7/19 @ 2PM at Dmitri's. The parade is on 9/1. He also talked about the Rezone Indy Project which is being funded by a federal grant.

Public Works Report – Dave Kieser was in attendance and advised the sign project is moving forward, we are waiting on the State Dept. of Transportation (INDOT). He also discussed a Capital Improvement Plan for the town for sidewalks and/or streets. Kieser Consulting would put together a 5 year plan for the town for \$1000. After a brief discussion, Mr. Eickhoff made the motion to approve Kieser doing the five year Capital Improvement Plan for the town and Mr. Mosier seconded. The motion was approved.

Special Projects Report – National Night Out is August 7th. A rough draft of the newsletter has been approved and printing will be next week. Mr. Mosier asked if note could be included about trimming trees and bushes that obstruct sidewalks and traffic/no parking signs. Mr. Hanson will include a note.

Police Department Report – National Night Out is 5:30 to 7:30 on 8/7. Mr. Eickhoff moved we purchase three laptops and software at a cost no greater than \$4400, Mr. Hanson seconded the motion. The motion carried. Mr. Eickhoff moved we spend \$660 for six tires for the squad cars, Mr. Hanson seconded the motion. The motion carried. 6595 Homestead garage was "tagged". 1411 Maynard was foreclosed upon and the previous owner forcibly entered the property. School will start on 7/31. On duty cell number for the MSDPT Police is 780-4296.
