

Minutes of Regular Meeting Of Homecroft Town Council

President Jones called the meeting to order, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The *Clerk/Treasure's report* was first on the agenda.

A motion was made by Mr. Eickhoff to approve the February 24th, 2014 council meeting minutes. It was seconded by Mr. Frizzell. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Mosier to approve the Claims for March. Mr. Eickhoff seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Public Comments – Kelly Foulk's with the mayor's office stated that the city is responding to potholes that need to be filled. These are being responded to as quickly as they can

Public Works Report – Steve Moore has had his engineering firm marking the utilities for the sign project. The signs may be installed as early as next week. Mr. Mosier has been looking at some of the potholes in the area and will follow up with these concerns.

Special Projects Report – Mr. Frizzell and Mrs. Jones went to the meeting on the School referendum March the 10th. It was informative and well attended. Some information has been put on the website.

Police Department Report – Chief Ryan would like 2,500 peel-off Homecroft badges at a cost of \$615.00 Mr. Eickhoff made a motion to purchase them at this amount within the next 30 days. Mr. Frizzell seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Chief Ryan made a motion to allow the officers to have business cards purchased for them. The count of 250 per officer for a total of \$520.00 was discussed. Mr. Eickhoff made a motion to purchase them at a price not to exceed \$520.00. Mr. Frizzell seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Chief Ryan made request to purchase “Simunition” training weapons. The request is to purchase 7 pistols, 4 rifle conversion kits and 2 marker rounds. The cost is \$4,750 to buy these out of the LEEF fund. Mr. Eickhoff made a motion to complete this purchase not to exceed \$4,750. Mr. Mosier seconded the motion. The motion carried.

May 25th “Kids Try for Kids Southport” is at 7:00 AM and runs till midnight.

Other Old/New Business-

Our next meeting will be on Tuesday April 21st, 2015.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Mr. Mosier @ 7:45 PM and it was seconded by Mr. Eickhoff. The motion passed.
