Acting President Frizzell called the meeting to order, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The *Clerk/Treasure's report* was first on the agenda.

A motion was made by Mr. Eickhoff to approve the February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2014 council meeting minutes. It was seconded by Mr. Mosier. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Mosier to approve the Claims for March. Mr. Eickhoff seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mr. Hanson informed the board that he contacted Comcast again and forwarded information to them on the parcel up near Speedway Indiana.

**Public Comments** – (Rex Joseph stepped out of the meeting during this discussion.) Joan Miller will work to represent those who are against the Plasma Center proposed at Southport and Madison. It is felt by to G.S.B.A. that this facility will not be a good neighbor in the area and are against a rezone for a plasma center and enlarging the area. They will have a public meeting here at this office on April 23rd at 6:00 to discuss this project. Southport is preparing a petition against this zoning change. May 15<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 will be the date for the hearing. Jack Sandlin spoke also on this project and inviting involvement in this. We will have Kyle write a letter for the board to challenge this project.

Kay Spear also spoke to the board in objecting to the plasma center. She also said she was preparing for the upcoming primary election.

Emmitt Carney who is also running for Marion Co. Sheriff also introduced himself to the board.

Ashley Davis with the Mayor's office shared information about Rebuild Indy 2 on the upcoming improvement in Indianapolis and also the Great Indy Clean-up on April 26<sup>th</sup> and anyone wishing more information on these programs are invited to contact her or look at the online information available.

**Public Works Report** – Contract from INDOT has been received. We will present for Kyle’s signature at next meeting. We will wait for notice to proceed.

**Special Projects Report** – Tim will provide black and white copy for information on the following Plasma center meeting. We will then be able to inform our neighbors of this planned change of use of this property.

**Police Department Report** – There have been few issues with the police department. We may be looking for the police vehicle later this year. Easter egg hunt will take place on Easter Weekend. Chief Ryan asked homeowners to go out in front of their homes at 10:00 at night and look to see if their address is visible. If the homeowner can’t see any numbers, then the Fire Department or Ambulance or Law Enforcement personnel will not be able to see it. This will increase response times on emergency runs.

**Other Old/New Business-** Rex did try to contact the party with the run in the town. They have not returned the call. Zach did read two letters from David Wantz and Sheriff Layton in response to Kyle’s letters to her.

Our next meeting will be on Tuesday April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2014.
