President Jones called the meeting to order, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The ***Clerk/Treasure's report*** was first on the agenda.

A motion was made by Mr. Eickhoff to approve the March 25th, 2014 council meeting minutes. It was seconded by Mr. Mosier. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Eickhoff to approve the Claims for April. Mr. Mosier seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The contract was provided for Huehls. Kyle read the prices and reviewed with the council. Tim motioned to accept the contract and Chris seconded the motion.

Mr. Hanson has signed up to some ongoing Clerk Treasurer's classes on May 7th and is asking the Board to reimburse the fee of \$105.00 for this class. Mr. Eickhoff motioned to reimburse for the fee and Mr. Mosier seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Public Comments – Ashley Davis with the Mayor's office discussed Rebuild Indy 2 is a \$35 million investment. Most of this information is available on line. Some of the road projects were discussed. There is a plan for a very large crime and gang awareness program in a couple months from now. This is planned to be held at the Southport High School. Tox Drop is on the second Saturday of the Month 9:00-2:00 here at the Township Building.

Public Works Report –The sign project is advancing with the engineering. The signs are being inventoried and INDOT is ready to release bids on the state website. Mr. Mosier may have a voucher soon to provide to Mr. Hanson. Chris has reported some potholes to the Mayors Pothole hotline. There is a sign at Maynard and Shelby also to replace. Kyle asked to have Huehls spray for weeds. Chris will follow up with this.

Special Projects Report –The newsletter is released to the members to be distributed right away. A survey has been done on the website to judge responses on the plasma center. This information has been provided by Zach to the proper outlets.
Kyle reviewed the meeting on the Plasma center this last week with standing room only crowd.

Police Department Report – Chief Ryan had a concern brought to him with the “no parking” on Dresden and requested parking on one side. There has been a request from the school district to ask for permission to park on the south side of Loretta on special event days. The school will provide a cover for the signage on the dates of these events. Mr. Eickhoff made a motion that will allow Chief Ryan ask the school to furnish dates for these special events with the decision to come at a later date. Mr. Frizzell seconded the motion.

Mr. Eickhoff stated they had found a police Cruiser from Greenwood for a 2007 Ford Crown Vic for the price of \$2500 and made a motion to allow Chief Ryan to pursue the purchase from the Greenwood Police Department. Mr. Frizzell seconded the motion. Officer Lowe will host a family day for the Homecroft Police Department on his Uncles property in Laurel Indiana on July 12th at 11:00 till 5:00.

Other Old/New Business- Mr. Joseph has had communication on the foot race that is proposed in the Town. Dan Moriarty the Township Trustee wanted to know about our interest in our lease that expires this fall. We will follow up at our next meeting on this issue. Mr. Joseph asked to change our July meeting to the 22nd instead of the current date posted of the 29th. Mr. Hanson will contact the star on the change of date.

Our next meeting will be on Tuesday May 20th, 2014.
