

Potholes on Orinoco between Banta and Maynard have been filled.

Chris fixed the street signs at Banta and Homestead and cleaned the town signs.

AT&T is working in the town now to run most of the fiber optic cables on the existing utility poles instead of burying them underground.

A resident at 1738 E Loretta reported a street and yard flooding issue. I went to talk with her and check out the situation, but it was a dry day. I also talked with a neighbor to the north about how the water on the adjacent properties is “supposed” to drain. It seems that one of the issues is the storm drain. After the next substantial rain, I’ll visit the area again and then reach out to DPW/CEG/MAC. I’m also working to get the subdivision plat for the area to see how it was planned for runoff water to move away from the houses and where this water was supposed to go. I’m hoping to get some solutions for this resident soon.

We are continuing to discuss ways to get more money to improve our streets since several of them are in need of repairs that we just don’t have the money to do.
