**Special Projects Report** – National Night out has been posted on the web site. Mr. Frizzell has been working with the "No Solicitation" ordinances for the town. He is doing more work with a survey. Feedback will follow this. Zach has been working on our digital newsletter as well.

**Police Department Report** – The Southport Homecoming parade is coming up on Sept. 25<sup>th</sup>. It has also been mentioned that the Coach Hathaway run is the day following on the

morning of the 26<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Eickhoff motioned to allow the parade on the 25<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Frizzell seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Chief Ryan has brought a request to purchase a new squad car. The purchase of a 2016 Dodge Charger will be approximately \$29,000. The purchase of lights, equipment, laptop and other misc. costs will be about \$7,000. The old gray car will be donated to ILEA for 2,500 credit hours at their facility. Mr. Eichhoff made a motion to spend \$36,000 to purchase this new vehicle. Mr. Frizzell seconded the motion. The motion carried.
