

Public Works Report

We had 3 water main breaks in the town on February 6th and 7th that were repaired by CEG on February 7th and 8th.

I've been checking the road sections damaged by the water main breaks in addition to the rest of the roads in the town as the snow has been melting. So far, I've noticed several potholes that have formed or worsened along Loretta.

I contacted the Mayor's Action Center several times in late January and early February about the drainage issues along Shelby. I called them before all of the snow and subsequent melting in order to try to be proactive leading into the spring. Since DPW didn't notice any issues when they came out, they said that there were no problems that needed fixed. The operator at the MAC recommended that I call again when there is actually water standing in the ditches and in the roadway so that they have something to see.
