
It is my hope that after reading this annual report, you will have a better understanding and share my mutual appreciation for the dedication and commitment of every member of our agency.

## Homecroft Police Department Agency Overview





#### 2023

- In 2023, the Homecroft Police Department participated in a Gang Task Force in cooperation with several other area law enforcement agencies in an effort to combat an increase in gang violence in and around our town.
- Our agency purchased 6 new rifles and completed a rifle school training event.
- HPD purchased body worn camera devices and will implement policies and procedures to permit their use in early 2024.
- Developed a partnership with the Central Indiana Police Foundation to better facilitate fundraising initiatives.

#### 2024-2025

- Quarterly Meet & Greet between town and officers: plan a hot dog or popcorn night for residents, officers & their families to meet.
- Evaluate & establish an in-house Investigations Division to help solve and prevent crimes that occur within town limits.
- Continue to enhance a Commendation plan to highlight officer's good work.
- Develop & implement "Coffee with a COP" program.

- Continue to increase patrol coverage of town.
- Create a new department patch and badge.
