**August 2022 Report for the 9/29/22 Council Meeting**

*Police Liaison Report to the Town Council*

13 Members of the Homecroft Police Department contributed 478 cumulative hours protecting and serving residents and visitors of the town in August 2022.

While patrolling 3,487 miles, officers wrote 93 town ordinance tickets, 6 state tickets, and issued 119 warnings citations. Their enforcement efforts resulted in 11 vehicles towed. They oversaw 33 total calls for service and assisted with 68 other calls for service. Most of these service calls were agency assist runs helping the Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department with calls in the vicinity of town.

Personnel Update: the 3 new officers have begun their Field Training programs. Veteran IMPD Officer Curtis Johnson has joined the HPD team and will assist with training, focusing on Field Training and Pre-Basic course instruction. Veteran Officer Alex Hernandez has re-joined the Homecroft Police Department and will be assisting with IT and Gang Intel. Curtis and Alex are both excellent additions to our police force and we give them a hearty welcome.

Monthly training consisted of Crash Report Reporting on the new Aries 6 platform as instructed by Ofc. Kevin Winks, and De-escalation Training conducted by Capt. Gregory.

The Chief has begun a contest to redesign the Homecroft PD patch; more details will be forthcoming about this project.


Public hearing on 2023 Budget was opened at 7:10pm.
